

Introduction to NewMEX

The New Mexico E-Rate Exchange (“NewMEX”) is a weekly E-rate newsletter prepared and distributed via listserv by E-Rate Central specifically for New Mexico applicants.

NewMEX is being distributed only on an “opt-in” basis to those New Mexico applicants who have subscribed by e-mailing their contact information to webmaster@e-ratecentral.com. Sample copies of the most recent NewMEX newsletters can be requested from the same e-mail address. In addition to the newsletters provided, we encourage all participants to use the NewMEX listserv as a way to share other information of interest to New Mexico E-rate applicants.

Additional state-specific E-rate information is available in the New Mexico section of the E-Rate Central Web site.¹ In particular, note that this site provides easy access to formatted New Mexico applicant E-rate histories via the Billed Entity Number (“BEN”) search mechanism in the upper left-hand corner. Detailed information can be obtained by “drilling down” using the links for specific funding years and individual FRNs.
